## IMPORTANT!

### Ground Rules for Young People Visiting Beaufort Court

1. Young people visiting Beaufort Court must be accompanied by adults with a ratio of 1 adult to 4 young people under the age of 11, and 1 adult to 7 young people between the ages of 11 and 18. These adults will be responsible for the safe behaviour of the young people in their charge.
2. You are advised to wear shoes suitable for rough terrain on your visit to Beaufort Court, and in winter to bring warm clothing to enable you to spend at least one hour outdoors.
3. If you are over the age of 16, you will be asked to wear a Visitor's Pass in a visible place during your visit to Beaufort Court.
4. You are reminded that Beaufort Court is a working environment. In particular, we ask that you:-
  - talk quietly whilst outside and *especially when near to the offices*.
  - respect the property of RES, both outside and inside the buildings.
5. *For your own safety, please*
  - do not run anywhere on the premises.
  - do not cross any safety barriers or go beyond any hazard signs
  - do not walk on the underground heat store
  - do not go up the steps when looking or at the solar panels
  - do not touch any of the plants on site unless instructed.
  - stay with your RES guide at all times.
6. In the event of a fire alarm or other emergency, you should go straight via the nearest fire exit (in the Auditorium or front entrance) to the assembly point by the wind turbine. Adults accompanying young persons should take responsibility for ensuring their group has reached the assembly point.
7. You are asked to place any rubbish in the recycling bins provided in the Auditorium.
8. There are toilets in the corner of the Auditorium for your use.
9. Drinking water is available at all times from the water dispenser in the Auditorium.

Your excellent behaviour is highly appreciated, and will ensure that we continue to host school children at our Beaufort Court offices.
