

Guidelines for visiting Beaufort Court:

1. Visitors are advised to wear sensible shoes suitable for rough terrain, and clothes suitable for spending an hour outside.
2. There is a fully accessible tour route for wheelchairs and those who prefer not to use steps. Please inform your tour guide in advance.
3. Adults will be given a Visitor's Pass on arrival, which you are asked to display in a visible place.
4. Visitors are reminded that Beaufort Court is a working environment. In particular, we ask that you:-
 - talk quietly whilst outside on the tour and especially whilst near to the building.
 - stay with your RES guide at all times
 - respect the property of RES, both outside and inside the buildings.
5. Visitors are not permitted to look inside the wind turbine tower base, the plant room or boiler room unless accompanied by an authorised person.
6. For your own safety, please
 - do not walk on the underground heat store or the solar panels.
 - do not run anywhere on the premises.
 - do not touch any of the plants on site unless authorised by RES staff.
7. In the event of a fire alarm or other emergency, visitors should go straight to the assembly point by the wind turbine. Adults accompanying school groups should take responsibility for ensuring their allotted children go to the assembly point.
8. Please place any rubbish in the recycling bins provided in the auditorium.
9. Photography is permitted as you tour *outside* the building only.
10. There is not charge for your visit, but any contributions to wish to make to our current staff-selected charity will be gratefully received on the day.
